

BSRIMA General Meeting Minutes

Meeting held via Zoom due to the current Covid-19 pandemic and campus closure

Thursday December 10, 2020

Meeting called to order at 7:02pm

Review meeting minutes of BSRIMA General Meeting minutes from September 2020

Motion made by Jennifer Ohlheiser to accept the minutes as written, Debbie Knight-Marshall seconds to motion. BSRIMA General Meeting minutes are accepted into record as written.

Treasurer's Report: Minimal activity/deposits or withdraws. Scrip account has a balance of \$579., and the general account has a balance of \$3,942. Taxes have been completed. Poinsettia fundraiser received a total of \$3,310. in orders, with a cost of \$2,268., and a profit of \$1,042.

President's Report: Poinsettia fundraiser complete. BSRIMA board election and positions for 2021 were discussed. Election for new BSRIMA board members will occur after the BSRIMA General Meeting on 12/10/2020. Fundraising ideas for 2021 will be discussed further by the new BSRIMA 2021 board (SNAP Raise, Vertical Raise, restaurant fundraisers) etc.

Director's Report: The end of semester is approaching. Unfortunately, due to Covid-19 pandemic BSR did not have a marching season for 2020. Students are working on recording videos of themselves to be submitted for a brief, upcoming, virtual concert. An email will be sent out to students and parents regarding the concert. Students may submit make up work until December 15th 2020. BSR drummers can rehearse. Color guard may be able to rehearse in January. District guidelines require one teacher/instructor for every nine students, due to the current Covid-19 pandemic. There are not enough instructors/coaches for the entire band to practice. There may be additional information/updates in January 2021. Guard has one instructor. Cohorts of 20-50 may be able to practice in April 2021. BSR may work on a parade march. BSR Seniors will be allowed to use a BSR uniform for senior pictures. Uniforms will have to be washed and safely returned to Mr. Jackson.

Elections: Elections for the 2021 BSRIMA board will take place virtually, due to the current Covid-19 pandemic, and JW North High School's campus closure. A Google form is available to all current BSRIMA members. During the BSRIMA General meeting via Zoom on 12-10-2020, a link is provided to all voting members. The following BSRIMA members/parents have expressed interest in the following BSRIMA board positions: Debbie Knight-Marshall (president), Carole Herrera (vice president band), Rose Cristales (vice president, auxiliary) and Nicole Petty (secretary). A treasurer for the BSRIMA board will be appointed by the new BSRIMA board. The floor is open for additional nominations. No other nominations presented. Period for

nominations is now closed. Election results are tallied via Zoom meeting and Google Form. BSR voting member/parent Jason Ohlheiser assisted in the tallying of votes, and reported the results to Mr. Jackson. BSRIMA board members/election results were shared with all BSR parents via text message/Remind.
