

## **BSRIMA General Meeting Minutes**

**Thursday November 12, 2020**

Meeting held via Zoom due to current Covid19 pandemic

Meeting called to order at 7:05pm

BSRIMA general meeting minutes from September 2020 were reviewed. Lisa Carty makes a motion to accept the minutes as written, Debbie Knight Marshall seconds the motion.

**Treasurer's Report:** As of October 31, 2020 BSRIMA account balance is \$4,567.04. Deposits of old uncashed checks were discussed and accounted for, as well as minimal credit/interest. Scrip balance is \$570. Winter drumline design was paid, in addition to BSRIMA taxes. 1099's for instructors was discussed.

**President's Report:** Upcoming election/process was discussed. Membership applications for 2020 should be completed by December 1<sup>st</sup> 2020, and can be found on the northbsr.com website. Elections for the BSRIMA board for 2021 will be held Thursday December 10, 2020. Positions available will be president, vice president band, vice president auxiliary, and secretary. A treasurer will be appointed by the 2021 BSRIMA board members. Interested parents should contact current BSRIMA secretary Nicole Petty at (951) 201-0835.

Poinsettias will be sold for a BSR fundraiser in December, for \$10. each. Parents will be notified through Remind. Money and order forms will be due December 4<sup>th</sup> 4-5pm at JW North High School, back parking lot. Orders can be picked up for delivery on December 10<sup>th</sup> between 3-5pm at JW North High School, back parking lot.

**Director's Report:** BSRIMA board election process will be different this year, due to the current Covid19 pandemic, and school site closure. Parents who have completed a BSR member application form by December 1, 2020, can vote via Zoom. One vote per family will be counted. The membership application form can be found on the northbsr.com website.

A tentative return to school date of January 18<sup>th</sup> 2021 was discussed. Riverside county is currently in the most restrictive red tier, and has to stay in that tier with no increase in positive cases, hospitalizations and deaths for seven weeks.

Master classes were discussed. Professional instructors are being paid through the school budget. Inventory such as personal protection equipment for students, bell covers, masks, bags for in person/instrument protection was discussed. \$18,284. was spent on purchasing new instruments such as saxophones and clarinets, to replace outdated instruments. New uniforms, uniform dressers/cabinets were also purchased. A new lock was also installed on the BSR trailer, as thefts can be frequent.

Marching Band as a physical education class credit in Spring was discussed, and may also be held virtually if in person instruction is not available. If in person instruction is permitted for second semester, Thursday night band rehearsal may resume.

Academic eligibility for BSR students was discussed. Students are given ample opportunity to improve individual assignment grades and over class grade.

**New Business:** Fundraising ideas were discussed. Ford test drive/fundraising was discussed. Snap Raise, and other ideas will be discuss/pursued by the BSRIMA 2021 board members.

Next BSR general meeting and election will be held Thursday December 10, 2020 at 7pm.
